RE: Retainer with Department of Justice

This will confirm that you have been retained by the Department of Justice of the Government of Manitoba to conduct prosecutions, inquests and provide opinions, on a case by case basis, as requested from time to time by Brian Kaplan, Director of Regional Prosecutions and Legal Education or Rob Finlayson, Assistant Deputy Attorney General, Prosecutions. This retainer will be effective from July 1, 2004, to March 31, 2005, inclusive. Any file referred to you within this time frame but not completed by March 31, 2005 will be included in this retainer unless agreement is reached otherwise with Brian Kaplan.

Your compensation will be [REDACTED] for time spent during the period from July 1, 2004 to March 31, 2005, plus reasonable disbursements necessarily incurred. If it is apparent that a matter referred to you is of such magnitude that it would not be reasonable to expect that it could be dealt with under the terms of this retainer, please contact Brian Kaplan and/or Rob Finlayson to discuss how this might be resolved.


If you are unable to provide service under this retainer due to illness or otherwise, Manitoba Justice may terminate it upon a date specified by it and you will be remunerated at the rate of [REDACTED] per hour for service provided to that date, to a maximum not to exceed the amount of the retainer.

In that regard, if you keep a record of your time on computer, you can simply provide us with a copy of your computer printout. A receipt should support any individual disbursements in excess of \$50.00, if at all possible.
