**RE: Further Evidence / Robert Taman and Victoria Sveinson**

I received information today and interviewed Robert Taman at 3:10 p.m. He reports that at some time close to the sentencing hearings, he received a telephone call from Martin Minuk. Mr. Minuk told him that his in-laws, the Sveinsons, were asking to have a picture of Crystal Taman "plastered" (he believes that word was used) throughout the courtroom. Mr. Minuk said he did not want the sentencing to become a circus and neither did Robert. Robert believes Mr. Minuk said they were large pictures. Because of the call and the way it was presented, Robert Taman opposed because of concern about his children staring at the picture all over the courtroom.

At a previous meeting, he believes his second meeting with Mr. Minuk, Mr. Minuk said he was not meeting with the Sveinsons or answering their calls or letters anymore. He said they are crazy and he was tired of them. Robert was left concerned that he may be saying the same things about him.

Victoria Sveinson would testify that they wanted 3 photographs to be provided to the judge, an 8 x 10 photo of Crystal, a photo of Crystal and her sister Corrine, and a newspaper articles photo of the yellow car.

I intend to ask the Commissioner tomorrow, June 11, 2008, to re-open the testimony of these witnesses to permit this evidence to be given.
