What I observed at the MVA on Feb. 25/05

pt to that car was deceased on scene and the Winnipeg
paramedics were working her in their truck.

The firefighters pointed to where the other pt was,
in the police SUV.

Ted and myself open the back doors to the PIC to see if
the pt needed our care. I noted a liquor odor immediately
and when he verbally refused our care I left Ted to
complete the paper work on him while I checked out
the pt's gray Dodge Dakota PU truck.

The pt seemed very depressed on scene and Ted and myself
both felt that alcohol consumption was a factor in this
collision. We returned to base when there was no patient for
us to care for.
